

State Fair Data Detectives Scavenger Hunt

Instructions: Become a Data Detective at the State Fair! Walk around and carefully observe what you see, hear, and taste. For each item below, make a tally mark or write down the information you collect in the "Data Collected" column. Have fun exploring!

Item to Observe/Experience	How to Collect Data	Data Collected
Something Red You See	Draw a quick sketch or write down what the red thing is.	
Different Animal Sounds You Hear	List each different animal sound you identify.	
A Food You Taste (Sweet)	Write down the name of the sweet food.	
Number of People Wearing Hats	Count and write down the total number of people.	
A Type of Music You Hear	Write down the style or instrument you hear.	
Something Tall You See	Draw a quick sketch or write down what the tall thing is.	
A Food You Taste (Savory)	Write down the name of the savory food.	
Number of Different Colors of Balloons	Count and list each different color you see.	
A Funny Sound You Hear (Not an animal)	Describe the funny sound.	

Something That Moves Fast You See	Write down what it is.	
A Food You Taste (Something New)	Write down the name of the new food and if you liked it!	
Number of Vehicles You See (Not Farm Animals)	Count and list the different types of vehicles.	

Bonus Challenges (Optional):

- Find the loudest sound you can hear and describe it.
- Find the smelliest thing you can smell and describe it (be careful!).
- Find someone who is wearing your favorite color. What are they wearing?

After the Scavenger Hunt:

- Talk about the different things you observed.
- Compare your data with your friends or family. Did you notice the same things?
- Which sense (sight, hearing, taste) gave you the most interesting data?
